

Alexander Dashevskiy

Born Leningrad in 1980. Graduated from St. Petersburg University for Film and Television, Department of Economics. Studied at St. Petersburg Repin Academy of Fine Arts, Department of Art History. Since 2005, he has been a member of the International Federation of Artists; Since 2006 - a member of the cooperative Free Culture and the Society of Painting and Drawing. His project *Partial Losses* is in the short list of Khandinskiy prize (2013). His work *Elektrosila* won Arte Laguna Prize, First prize section painting (2016).
